

COMMANDER'S TROPHY POINTS YOKOTA AIR BASE, JAPAN

- A.** The Commander's Trophy will be awarded annually to the unit accumulating the most point in the intramural Sports Program at Yokota Air Base. This trophy is a traveling trophy and will be kept by the winning organization for one year until the next winners are announced.

- B.** One large unit (101 or more active duty personnel assigned), and one small unit. (100 or less active duty personnel) The manning document will be used to determine the number of personnel assigned. Commander's Trophy teams may consist of active duty military personnel, dependents 18 or older, DOD, GS, NAF Civilians and Japanese Nationals.

- C.** The competition will start with Bowling and end with Flag Football

- D.** Correct totals will be kept by fitness center personnel and will be presented at each Sports Advisory Council meeting. Final results will be given out during the Wing Sports Day.

- E.** If an organization wins the trophy three consecutive years, that unit will be awarded a designated trophy of achievement.

- F.** Intramural team sports (basketball, softball, racquetball, golf, bowling, volleyball, soccer and flag football)

- G.** All squadrons that combine teams will split all points earned. If the splitting of points results in an uneven number of points, the extra points will be awarded, to the coach's squadron.

- H.** Unit participation points:
 - 1. Entering the intramural league: 10
 - 2. Finishing the intramural league: 3
 - 3. League Regular Season Placing: 1st = 24, 2nd = 21, 3rd = 18, 4th = 15, 5th = 12, 6th = 9, 7th = 6, 8th = 3.
 - 4. Entering Playoffs: 5
 - 5. League Playoff Placing: 1st = 25, 2nd = 15, 3rd = 10.
 - 6. Coaches Meeting: 3 (w/ combined teams, points will go to Unit that provides Head Coach)
 - 7. Sports Advisory Meeting: 5
 - 8. Three game forfeits during the season: -10
 - 9. Any Player ejected for unsportsmanlike conduct: -5

Note: Extramural and recreational teams (Fitness, Wing or HAWC runs, Sport Clubs, Varsity Teams) will not receive any points in the intramural programs.
